Description of Fundraising Events

Krispy Kreme – The Krispy Kreme fundraiser is available solely to assist families with registration fees should they need it. Paper Krispy Kreme certificates can be purchased upfront and sold by families, or supporters' emails and funds can be collected, and certificates can be sent digitally to them. Certificates never expire and can be used at any Krispy Kreme across the country. *A total of 50 certificates must be sold at \$13 each to reach the registration fee.*

Buckeye Day with the Braves – This fundraiser is designed to act as a group outing for our upcoming Buckeyes athletes! Not only will this be a fun filled day out with fellow Buckeyes, but it will allow our program to raise a few dollars for the season ahead.

SnapRaise - This campaign is design for our Buckeye athletes to have a way to reach out to friends and family located not only in our community, but also extended family outside of our area who would like to help our program. The expectation is that each player should enter 20 emails into the SnapRaise system. If a player does not enter 20 emails into the system by July 7, there will be a \$100 fee.

Car Wash Cards – All players are required to sell ten (10) cards @ \$20 each for a total of \$200. The \$200 must be turned directly into your teams' team mom or Coach Meg.

Ad Sales – Each athlete is expected to *attempt* to sell advertising or sponsorships to local businesses consisting of Spirit Book ads and/or game day banners. If a player sells a total of \$700 **OR** \$500 plus sells all 10 of their Buckeye books, they will receive their registration fees back. A list of sponsorship levels can be collected from Coach Meg

*Individual team fundraisers will be implemented by each age group/team for additional team swag packs, uniforms, end of season banquets and additional team expenses *Numbers are based off of 150 athlete organization

Volunteering

All parents are expected to volunteer throughout the season at least **2x.** A \$50 volunteer check or CC authorization form will be collected and will be cashed should you choose not to participate at the conclusion of the season.

Questions You May Have

Do I have to pay \$300 (\$350 for cheer) for my athlete to be a Buckeye? YES

However, we are offering an early registration discount and payment plan options

- Pay in full before June 3 Registration is \$250 (\$300 for cheer)
- Make payments towards the total amount due, last payment due on August
 2
- Scholarships are open and available to apply on our website at www.gabuckeyes.com/scholarship-opportunities

- Participate in Krispy Kreme Fundraiser

If payment is not completed in full by August 2, 2024, your athlete will not be able to participate in practice or games until payment is made.

What is expected out of my athlete from the organization?

- \$300 (\$350 for cheer) registration fee
- 20 emails loaded into SnapRaise or \$100 fee
- \$200 raised via Car Wash Card sales
- Participation in the individual team fundraisers

How can I help reduce registration fees? Each athlete can participate in the Krispy Kreme fundraiser to offset registration fees. Each athlete is also expected to *attempt* to sell a minimum of \$500 in advertising from Spirit Book ads and/or banners. If a player sells a total of \$700 **OR** \$500 in advertising plus sells all 10 of their Car Wash cards, they will receive their registration fees back. Please contact Coach Meg for a list of advertising pricing and sponsorship packages

What happens if I don't sell any advertising or fundraise? Your individual coaches and team moms will be given the status of each player weekly to make sure these goals are being worked on. The need for the program and the expectation is that every player meets their goals.

What does the \$300 fee provide? While the \$300 does not cover the actual per player cost, it does help defray some of the expenses. Please refer to the website for a list of what registration covers.

Why do you want me to pay now instead of in the Fall? Funds are needed now to purchase necessary equipment, uniforms, and other capital needs prior to the start of the regular season. 2024 Buckeye season is in full swing already!

Aren't the Buckeyes responsible to pay for the season? No, the Buckeyes organization is a non-profit organization and completely volunteer based. Coaches, team moms, and board members (including the President) do not earn any income off the organization. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the members (athlete parents) to fund the athlete's experience. The Buckeyes make it a priority to keep costs to a minimum and provide ample opportunity for fundraising/financial assistance for families in need. The more we raise, the more experiences we can provide for your athletes.

Are refunds available if my athlete decides not to participate with the **Buckeyes?** No refunds will be issued for any reason after the start of mandatory practice on July 8, 2024. Or if uniforms have already been ordered.
